Identify or show evidence of at least ten kinds of wild animals (birds, mammals, reptiles, fish, mollusks) found in your community.

\*\*\* These requirements are intended for all scouts who have not yet reached the rank of **First Class**

Identify or show evidence of at least ten kinds of native plants found in your community.

\* Rank column: TF=Tenderfoot, SC=Second Class, FC=First Class

\*\* Location column: T=Requirement may be done at troop meeting or outing, O=Requirement should be done on an outing, H=Requirement can optionally be done at home.

\*\*\* Scouts may study beyond their current rank. For example, a scout studying his Tenderfoot requirements may successfully complete a First Class requirement, so therefore should be included in all 3 lesson groups (TF, SC, & FC).
